At present China is the biggest market of refractory industry in the world. In 2008 China import 21.24 thousand tons and export 4.94 million tons of refractory materials and products. The total trade volume reached \$ 2.29 billion, up 54.77% over the previous year. In 2008 the production

of crude steel in China is 500 million tons, covering 38.28% of the world's total output. In the first quarter of this year, the proportion of China's steel output accounted for 48.34% of the world. Thus China has a great demand on the refractory product, which is important in iron and steel industry.

The Center of Global Market

China has been the biggest steel producing and consuming country in the world for twelve years. She is also the biggest casting producer for more than seven years, covering 30.7% of the world's output in 2007. In response to the challenges of the global financial crisis, Chinese Central Government has put forward a series of policies since 2008, including the stimulation of economic development, the expansion of domestic demand and a massive infrastructure construction. This is definitely providing enormous room for the growth of metallurgy and foundry industry. No doubt the three shows will be the powerful tools to promote the products in the Asia-Pacific region when you always have so much to do with limited budget under the current economic situation.

Conference

Besides the exhibition itself, the concurrent conference is another high light. The 6th China International Steel Congress and the 9th China Foundry Association Congress will be staged as usual.
